

Duality Expanded Friday 25th July 7-10pm

Artists: Carla Fleck, Lawrence Mathias, Nicholas Peart, Silvio Severino, Terryfy

Programme: Each artist will present slides and/or videos and talk about their work.

Duality Expanded focuses on the works of 5 artists from the current Duality exhibition. Each artist offers a different and unique interpretation around the concept of Duality.

The photographer Carla Fleck presents diferent situations of Duality in her series of photographs, RASPAS, which were executed throughout London from torn and abandoned posters unnoticed by passers by or perceived as worthless leftovers. They are fragmented and aligned, giving them a new meaning by revealing their hidden beauty, secrets and all their duality within their abstract reality.

Artist Lawrence Mathias will be showing his video 'How We Cut Our Ties', which explores our preoccupation with the afterlife and the inevitable tension between reality and faith. This is an aspect of duality with an increasing effect on how many people lead their lives.

Multi media artist Nicholas Peart will be showing his short film 'Atlantic: East And West Land's End Extremes', which was filmed during his recent eight month journey across Latin America and West Africa. His film highlights the geographical and spiritual duality between the most eastern land point of the Americas and the most western land point of Africa facing the Atlantic Ocean. He will also be taking about his trip.

Brazilian born photographer, GIF animation and collage artist Silvio Severino makes highly personal works. His collage work is based on vintage and contemporary printed images, which are reworked to explore the notions of beauty, gender and sexuality in today's capitalist society.

Photographer Terryfy is inspired by faces found in everyday places. His photographs contain objects which resemble the appearance of a face giving a sense of duality to them.
